CONDITIONS FOR ENROLMENT INTO SMART & SKILLED TRAINING

Please note that as part of the enrolment process, the following evidence is required in regard to eligibility where the situation is applicable to the student.

1. Completed Enrolment Form (e.g legible writing, valid USI, all fields completed)
2. Copy of evidence(s), must be provided with your completed enrolment form, as listed in the table below.
