### Testamurs (Qualifications) to be awarded

On successful completion of the entire course you will be awarded a nationally recognized testamur:

SIT30716 Certificate III in Hospitality (Restaurant Front of House) with an academic transcript.

Upon receiving your testamur and transcript, you can use this to gain credit for units completed and be awarded an academic transcript toward a Certificate IV in Hospitality. You will be eligible to complete the Certificate IV in Hospitality and be awarded a testamur and transcript upon completion.
