

CHP RSL GROUP WILL CONTINUE TO REQUIRE VACCINATION PROOF AS A CONDITION OF ENTRY UNTIL AT LEAST JANUARY 2022.

Camperdown Commons is a subsidiary company of CHP RSL Group.

We wish to inform our community that Canterbury-Hurlstone Park RSL Club group has made the decision to extend the requirement of mandatory proof of COVID-19 vaccination (or medical exemption) as a condition of entry for staff and patrons beyond 15 December 2021, and will review the situation in January 2022. This will apply to all of our hospitality venues.

Whilst the government continue to change restrictions in the hospitality industry, and Clubs will still be required to facilitate QR code check ins beyond 15 December 2021, we do not believe that this is the right time to remove the requirement for proof of COVID-19 Vaccination (or exemption).

With the emergence of the new 'Omicron' strain of COVID-19, and the ongoing uncertainty of the impact it may have, coupled with varied rates of vaccination in our local communities, we are taking this proactive step to maintain proof of COVID-19 vaccination until at least January 2022.

After engaging with our membership and our staff, we believe that this decision will be favoured by an overwhelming majority of our community, and that it is in the best interests of the health and safety of our staff, members and patrons at this time. We will continue to monitor the situation to determine when it will be appropriate for us to remove the policy.

Getting a COVID-19 Vaccination Record



How to get a record of your COVID-19 vaccination

Proof of your COVID-19 vaccination will be recorded on your **immunisation history statement** after you've had your vaccine.

Once you have received all required doses, you will also be able to access your **COVID-19 digital certificate**.

You can get proof of your COVID-19 vaccination through:

- Medicare online account
- Express Plus Medicare app
- My Health Record
- Individual Healthcare Identifiers Service
- Australian Immunisation Register

Medicare online account

- 1. Sign in to your **myGov** account (my.gov.au) and choose **Medicare**
- 2. From the **Immunisation history** section, select **View immunisation history**
- 3. Choose your name
- 4. Click on View immunisation history statement (PDF) or View COVID-19 digital certificate (PDF)

Express Plus Medicare app

- 1. Open the app and sign in
- 2. From the **Services** section, choose **Immunisation history**
- 3. Choose your name
- 4. Click on View immunisation history statement (PDF) or View COVID-19 digital certificate (PDF)

My Health Record

You can also get proof of your COVID-19 vaccinations from My Health Record.

If you already have a My Health Record:

- Sign in to your **myGov** account (my.gov.au) and choose **My Health Record**
- 2. Open your My Health Record
- Access proof of your vaccinations from your **Record Home** page or from your **Immunisations view** page (select **Documents, Immunisations**)

If you don't already have a My Health Record, but you have a Medicare card:

- Sign in to your **myGov** account (my.gov.au) and link to **My Health Record**
- Verify your identity and create a My Health Record, making sure to select 'Yes' to include immunisations information (Medicare information) in your My Health Record
- 3. Open your My Health Record
- Access proof of your vaccinations from your **Record Home** page or from your Immunisations view page

Getting a COVID-19 Vaccination Record

Individual Healthcare Identifiers service (if you don't have a Medicare card)

If you don't have a Medicare card and want to access proof of your vaccinations online, you will need an Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI). If you don't already have an IHI, you can apply for one online.

- Sign in to your myGov account (my.gov.au) and choose Individual Healthcare Identifiers service
- 2. From the **Services** section, choose **Immunisation History**
- 3. Click on View immunisation history statement (PDF) or View COVID-19 digital certificate (PDF)

Australian Immunisation Register

If you can't get proof of your COVID-19 vaccinations online, call the

Australian Immunisation Register on 1800 653 809 between 8am-5pm, Monday to Friday.

Ask them to send your **immunisation history statement** to you.

It can take up to 14 days to arrive by mail.

If you need an interpreter, please call the Telephone Interpreter Service (TIS) on 131 450.
