It was a cool morning that 19 of us hit off at Kareela G.C., down on numbers as a few were playing in a Mixed Foursomes Event (known as the Sorry Game) at Bardwell Valley G.C., Craig Tomison was competing in the City to Surf and about three weere on holidays.

The tips of the fingers took a while to thaw out, as we played the first few holes in the shadows of the valley that make up this course, until we worked our way up and over the ridge and felt the warmth of the sunshine and blew the cobwebs out of the system. Our place getters on the day all had slow starts except for Sifa Nacagelivu who parred the 2^{nd} after winning the NTP.

The blood must of being well and truly pumping for Glenn Watson watching his 2^{nd} shot into the 7^{th} green with the ball finishing 300mm behind the hole winning the NTP, finishing off a birdie for a 3-a-5. Not to be outdone, Sifa Nacagalevu also had a birdie for a 3-a-5 on the 4^{th} hole.

My birdie on the 8th 2-a-4, saved me from having the lowest score on the front nine but still was equal lowest shared with Joe Oriti, David DeMarchi and Peter Deady with 11 s/b points. My back nine was a vast improvement, eliminating the 3 wipes and shot 22 s/b points to have the best back nine score to finish in the middle of the pack.

Greg Parsell hit a wayward shot towards the 3rd green where the ball ended up coming to rest on the bench seat at the back tees for the 9th tee, luckily not coming to rest in the sand box which would of been an interesting sand trap shot. Peter Deady on the 4th hole nearly parted his eyebrows when a safety shot from on the 3rd back up the hill to 4th fairway, hit a tree dead center and came back at him nearly with Deadly consequences and using all the skills of Anthony Mundine to duck and weave to avoid a knockout blow. He took a wipe after that swipe.

The course was the first time I had played it without it being waterlogged, so we got a lot more run than usual. The greens were reasonably fast with some interesting positioning of cups on the greens that helped add to your score if you were a bit bold with your putting. As we all stood around the 18th, you had to be vigilant while putting above the hole or the ball would sail straight past leaving a difficult shot back
