It was interesting that the 4 combatants in the Matchplay games all scored 45 stablepoints with only Glenn Watson coming home with 26pts on the back nine, Greg 24, Craig 23, Mal 23, & James 22 points so even the count back on the back nine were close.

The A and B Graders are looking to the longer courses before they can get some vouchers. Usually we play for the Par 3 Championship as well at Randwick but we will be contesting that Trophy at Russell Vale, Wollongong later this year.
