As you may know from our July e-newsletter, we submitted a development application (DA) to Marrickville Council for 31A Mallett St Camperdown. If you are a neighbour of the Mallet Street site, you may have received written notice about the DA and we understand a number of you took the opportunity to submit feedback to Council.

At this time the application is still with Council, and we look forward to sharing news with you regarding the submission when a decision is made.

If you have walked or cruised past the bowling greens at the former club site, you may have noticed that Pocket City Farms, our urban farming partner, has planted a summer 'green manure' crop to help boost the soil's nutrient levels. This is an essential step to bringing the soil nutrient profile up to the standard needed to grow the most delicious seasonal vegetables, herbs and fruit around!

To give the soil an even bigger boost, you may have seen Zag, Adrian and other members of the Pocket City Farms team on-site, planting seeds and turning over the compost. You may even be one of our neighbours who already kindly offered to supply your own suitable kitchen scraps.
